

Greeting Card Boxes

1. Cut card at fold (in the middle)
2. Make sure both sides are the same size.
3. Choose the most decorative side of the card; this will be the top.
4. Turn it over so that the inside of the card (non-decorated side) is face up. Draw an X from corner to corner.
5. Draw a very small rectangle over the center of the X.
6. Fold each side of the paper to the lines of the rectangle; making sure the fold is clean and sharp.
7. Folding the card has provided creases. Following the crease on the shorter side of the card, cut to the end of the crease.
8. Erase the pencil marks.
10. Use a glue stick and apply glue all over the inside of the larger flap, fold the other two flaps in towards each other and fold the top of the larger flap over the two flaps. Hold with a clothespin until the glue sets. Do the same on the opposite side.
11. Now go back to step 5 and draw an X on the other half of the card. This will be the bottom of the box so it needs to be a bit smaller. DO NOT draw a rectangle in the middle of the X, instead, simply fold to the center of the X this time. Cut and glue as before.
12. You can choose to decorate a rock with sharpies provided (you can add a word, or designs) to put inside the box or you can write a special note to put inside. Put a bow on it and you have a special present to give to someone you love! Happy Holidays 😊
